The Harmonized System: Identifying Schedule B and HS Codes

The Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding System (HS) of tariff nomenclature is an internationally standardized system of names and numbers for classifying traded products developed and maintained by the World Customs Organization (WCO). Attendees will learn how to navigate the Harmonized System in determining HS and Schedule B Codes for their products. The teaching method for the workshop is comprised of lecture, on-line demonstrations and group discussion. The relaxed atmosphere of the course allows for attendees to ask questions at any time as the seminar notes and meeting minutes are already provided to everyone in their workshop narrative book. This format allows the attendee to focus on the presented subject matter and participate in group discussion.

The seminar will cover:

- Overview of the Harmonized System.
- How to identify Schedule B and HS Codes for your company's products.
- Understanding of the 6 General Rules of Interpretation.
- Learn how to identify the duty rates of products that you are importing into the U.S.

- Understanding of interpreting the rules of origin for your products under NAFTA and other Free Trade Agreements, based on your product(s) HS Codes.
- Learn how to research U.S. Customs & Border Protection Binding rulings utilizing the CROSS system and how to electronically apply for a Binding Ruling Request for your products.
