NOTICE OF DISPOSITION – DOCKET 2020-1

This notice reflects proposed amendments considered by the Commodity Classification Standards Board (CCSB) at the public meeting on February 11, 2020, and the action of the CCSB on each proposal.

Dispositions resulting in amendments to the National Motor Freight Classification® (NMFC®) will be published in a supplement to the NMFC, unless reconsideration is granted in accordance with the CCSB's rules. The supplement is scheduled to be issued on March 26, 2020, with an effective date of April 25, 2020.

The CCSB may, in its discretion and for good cause shown, reconsider any docketed proposal on which disposition has been made. Requests for reconsideration must be made by mail, email or fax by a party of record to the proposal and must be received in my office no later than 5:00 pm Eastern Time, March 2, 2020.

Comment

The provisions of item 45463, Organic Peroxides, NOI, other than toxic, are amended by establishing classes predicated on whether or not the material is subject to temperature control requirements and by the organic peroxide type for the non-temperature-controlled materials. Class 200 is assigned to organic peroxides requiring temperature control and, as modified, the following classes are assigned to organic peroxides not requiring temperature control: class 200 for Type B, class 125 for Type C, class 110 for Type D, class 100 for Type E and class 92.5 for Type F. Also as modified, the item description expressly states that temperature control requirements are as per U.S. DOT regulations.
