#### Item (Rule) 250, Definition of or Specifications for Cylinders, is amended as follows:

#### **⇒ITEM 250**

#### DEFINITION OF OR SPECIFICATIONS FOR CYLINDERS

**Cylinders** are used for shipping materials under pressure and must be constructed in conformance with the applicable requirements of Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR). Materials authorized in this Classification to be shipped in steel cylinders will also be accepted in cylinders of other construction, provided that such materials are specifically authorized in the DOT's regulations or by DOT special permit to be shipped in such cylinders.

Cylinders tendered for shipment on lift truck skids, pallets or platforms must be secured to the lift truck skid, pallet or platform in a manner to withstand the normal rigors of the less-thantruckload environment. Cylinders oriented horizontally on lift truck skids, pallets or platforms must not overhang the lift truck skid, pallet or platform deck.

**Boxes** are containers with solid or closely fitted sides, ends, bottoms and tops. They must be made of wood, see Note 1, metal, plastic, see Note 2, ⇒or fiberboard, see Item 222, and must completely enclose their contents. Unless otherwise provided in individual items, boxes must be securely closed. The term does not include cylindrical, conical or taper-sided containers, which are specifically defined as: Drums, Pails or Tubes.

#### SPECIFICATIONS FOR BUNDLES, COILS, REELS OR ROLLS

**Bundles, coils or rolls** must be banded, strapped, wrapped or otherwise protected or secured in a manner that will permit handling into or out of vehicles as units and withstand the normal rigors of the less-than-truckload environment. Where necessary to afford adequate protection against damage, article(s) must be protected by packing forms or other packaging materials. When tendered on lift truck skids, pallets or platforms, bundles, coils or rolls must be securely fastened to and must not overhang the lift truck skid, pallet or platform deck.

**Reels** must have a core and two ends or heads of equal size with a diameter of 10 inches or more. When tendered on lift truck skids, pallets or platforms, reels must be securely fastened to the lift truck skid, pallet or platform, which must be of sufficient design, size and strength to support the size and weight of the reel and the article wound thereon.  $\exists$ Except where more specifically provided in individual items, the last layer of the article must be lagged or wrapped between the flanges of the ends or heads with packaging material extending full width of the wound article and of sufficient strength to withstand the normal rigors of the less-than-truckload environment.

Each carboy must be in a box or crate. Necks of carboys may project through an opening in the top of the box or crate. Carboys completely enclosed in a box must have the sides of the box marked with directional arrows and other applicable precautionary markings as specified in Item 682. Glass carboys in crates or wood boxes must have packing forms or other packaging materials necessary to provide sufficient cushioning and protection to withstand the normal rigors of the less-than-truckload environment.
